

TOILET TRAINING PROCEDURE

When the nursery and parents feel that a child is ready, they will start the training process. This process will start depending on the child's development, capabilities and understanding. The nursery will require parents to help and support throughout this process.

The whole toilet training process will be made fun and exciting for the child. There will be lots of praise for the child. Any accidents the child may have will be made as part of the learning process.

- The child will be introduced to the toilet during every nappy change and encouraged to sit on it.
- Once the child starts to do something on the toilet and can ask for it, the nursery will ask the parents/ carers to put the child in normal underwear.
- The child will be regularly taken to the toilet and will be encouraged to ask for the toilet.
- The child will wear a nappy during sleep time and only when they remain dry will the nappy be kept off.
- Visits to the toilet will be decreased once the child starts to ask for the toilet independently.

As each child is different, they may start at different stages and progress differently.
